### FORMAT - TWO PERSON SCRAMBLE

**GROSS & NET PAYOUTS** (can only receive one prize).

Team handicaps figured based on following:

Low player: 50% handicap

2nd low: 20% handicap

*Round up at .5 and add the 2 numbers for the team handicap. Handicaps are from the tees each player is playing from. Max individual event handicap is 22 before reduction...players above 22 will be lowered to 22. The event will be pre-flighted if entry numbers merit doing so...otherwise we will pay the top 30 % of gross teams and top 30% of net teams. All ties broken from Hole 18 backward.*

**NOTE: YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO USE AT LEAST 4 TEE SHOTS FROM EACH PLAYER DURING THE ROUND. Each unused tee shot will result in a 2 shot penalty.**

Men 49 & Under: Green Tees (6500)

Men 50-64: White Tees (6000)

Men 65-79: Gold Tees (5600)

Men 80+ and Ladies: Red Tees (5100)

### ENTRY FEE

VV Members: \$50 (plus appropriate cart fee)

Non-Member\*: \$100 (includes golf/cart & prizes)

**Entry Fee includes Lunch buffet after golf.**

### SHOTGUN START

This event will be an 10 am Shotgun Start (EST).

Buffet/Scoring will be done in the Pavilion after golf.

### DEADLINE:

**THE ENTRY DEADLINE IS WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 25th AT NOON OR THE FIRST 50 TEAMS TO ENTER.**

*Valley View Members only can enter their team through February 15. February 16 and after, this is an open event. All players must have verifiable USGA handicaps from an authorized golf facility (No "Apps") taken. Any players without a verifiable USGA handicap will be placed as scratch.*

### For Members of Valley View...

If you had a handicap in 2025 you should already be in the system unless you did not post any scores in 2025. You will have been deactivated if no scores were posted. If you are a Member and wish to re-start a deactivated handicap, just call the Golf Shop. If you are a new Member and wish to have a handicap, simply stop by the Golf Shop and leave a note for Tom or Josh. We will need an email address, and your date of birth.

### For non-Members, go to...

[www.indianagolf.org](http://www.indianagolf.org) and follow the instructions under Handicapping. You can pay your yearly fee online and classify your home facility. If you have had your handicap at Valley View in the past and are not a Member at Valley View, you simply re-activate by paying your 2026 IGA Membership.

## VALLEY VIEW APPRECIATES ALL OF OUR MEMBERS & WELCOMES OUR NEWER MEMBERS...Here are some of our policies to help our new Members get started and our other Members brush up!

### A FEW THINGS OF NOTE FOR ALL...

As we head into the dog days of winter at Valley View Golf Club, we would like to welcome all of our new Members who have taken advantage of our Holiday Promotion and joined our Club recently. We look forward to having you as Members and hope you will take advantage of our events as we start the new season in 2026. There are a few reminders we would like to put about some standard rules on the course so all of those using the facility can have a great time.

**BOOKING TEE TIMES** - One of the perks of Membership is being able to book 2 weeks out, whereas the general public can only book one week ahead. You should have access to booking tee times 2 weeks in advance using the "Member" portal when booking online. If, for some reason, you are not able to access your account, please try the following:

**ONLINE BOOKING ISSUES** - Your device used to book (especially your phone) can keep you logged in as a Member all of the time and that can make things work incorrectly at times. Try logging out and then back in and see if that helps. If that does not care care of the issue, call the Golf Shop and we can send a link to reset your password.

**DUPLICATE ACCOUNTS** - DO NOT set up another account as a public player. That will cause a problem in the system and is difficult to correct.

**SINGLES**...The only way you can book a time online as a single is if it is with another 2 or 3 players. We do not take bookings for singles until the day of the tee time. PLEASE DO NOT BOOK AS A TWOSOME TO WORK AROUND THIS IF YOU KNOW YOU ARE BY YOURSELF. Simply call the Golf Shop and we will take care of you on the day you want the tee time.

**TEE TIME CANCELLATIONS**...Online booking is a very convenient way to get a tee time when the Golf Shop is closed or you are in a position when you can't talk to a Golf Shop Staff Member, but it has its faults as well. Here are a few requests with online booking and facts you may not know...

- You may have trouble trying to cancel a tee time online. You cannot cancel online times inside of 2 hours before the tee time. You must call in to do so.
- Cancelling a Tee Time...If you have more than one person listed on your tee time and wish to cancel the tee time online, you must cancel each player listed on the tee time or the system will simply eliminate the one player cancelling and leave the time there with the other players listed. If that time is not fully cancelled, those remaining on the time will be tagged as a NO-SHOW and online privileges will be suspended until corrected. It is always safer to call in if you do not know the credentials of all of the players in the group. Booking a tee time in one person's name only does not result in charging that person for the entire group.

We understand that things change, but please let us know if you need to cancel your time or if there are changes to your group size. Losing the ability to fill an open tee time can cost the Club over \$270 on just cart & greens fees. Our Membership fees are very reasonable since we balance Membership Fees with cart and greens fees for general public bookings. Even if it is one hour prior or less, your cancellation or tee time change communication is greatly appreciated.

### PACE OF PLAY/FIVESOMES/REFRESHMENTS AT THE TURN...

**PACE OF PLAY** - With the number of rounds we have at Valley View, pace of play is always something we strive to work on. We request that everyone gets around in 2 hours per nine holes or 18 Holes in 4 hours or less. Some days as the day drags on, 4 1/2 hours may be the norm when we go over the 230 player mark. We know some players are capable of playing faster, but that isn't always feasible. On busy days, letting slower groups "play through" is simply not the answer...it actually slows things down. When it's an option, with safety in mind, we highly recommend "ready golf". Ask those in the Golf Shop if you need that defined and we will help you out!

**FIVESOMES** - At Valley View, we went away from fivesomes a couple of seasons ago and from the management side of the counter and the customer side, that is a much better plan. Last November we decided to allow fivesomes after Daylight Savings Time starts in November and end the ability to play fivesomes when it reverts in March. We are simply going to eliminate fivesomes starting March 2nd this year. In-season, please do not ask to play a fivesome, no matter the reason...we will say no. The only time we allow fivesomes "in season" is during special events or outings when the entire course is reserved. Thanks in advance for your understanding.

**REFRESHMENTS AT THE TURN** - Let's face it, a big part of golf is great food and beverage. With Tap Ins (and they are great), we are working to make a smooth transition at the turn in getting food & beverage in a timely manner and going to the 10th tee to eliminate delays. We are working on the perfect answer in making that as efficient as possible. We have most of our phone issues solved and you can call from hole #8 and get your order set up for the turn (even drink/cooler only orders) and we will continue to work on this. With the Tap In's Staff serving both "on course" golfers, and non-course patrons at the same time, it is sometimes tough for them to get the golfers served in a timely manner without a little heads up.

**We DO NOT allow groups to stop, sit down, and eat at the turn and expect to jump back into the flow on the 10th tee.** This almost always creates a major logjam. If you are on the course and playing 18 holes, please take your refreshments with you to keep the flow!

### GOLF CART USAGE...

We have raised the cart fee for regular play, but have kept it the same for Members. A few simple items and requests on the carts...

**WHERE CAN THEY GO** - Simply put, carts can go almost anywhere with these exceptions...

- Must stay on the paved paths on the Par 3s.
- Must stay about 30 feet from the greens.
- Cannot leave the property (no neighbor's yards).
- Should return to the paved paths at least 30 feet from the green and stay there until teeing off on the next hole.

**NUMBER OF RIDERS & NON GOLFING RIDERS** - The only single rider carts allowed are those that are dictated by the number of players in the group (singles/threesomes).

Three players cannot take 3 separate carts. If you have a non-golfing rider and it requires an extra cart, please be prepared to pay an extra public cart fee (\$21). On certain days, we won't be able to allow extra carts for groups with non-golfing riders due to the number of golfers booked. You might consider calling ahead before bringing a rider along.

**DARKNESS** - We do require that all rental carts be off of the course at posted sunset for the day to allow time for our staff to clean and stow the carts for use the next day. This does not mean 25 minutes after this posted time to get those last 3 holes in. Please turn all rental carts in as soon as your round is complete. If receiving a message on the Fairway IQ GPS, please follow return instructions.

### FAIRWAY IQ (Golf Cart GPS)

For those that played the 2nd half of 2025, you have used our Golf Cart GPS units. They have added a great new dimension to riding at Valley View. For the future, the carts will soon let you know if you are driving into a restricted area. (too close to the greens, etc...). You can also see where the carts are in front of you which is a great feature for holes like #11. Please use and enjoy the features, and please note any notes sent to your group/cart concerning speed of play, cart return notices, etc...

### BACK 9 STARTS & TURNING AFTER PAYING FOR 9 HOLES

You must check in at the Golf Shop if you wish to try and start on the back 9. At busy times, this probably will not work with groups making the turn, but we are happy to check. Check in the Golf Shop and they will let you know your options.

We have had a growing problem with people paying for 9 and making the turn without checking in or paying for the back 9. Please make sure you check in at the Golf Shop before turning if you only paid for 9.

### COMMUNICATION...

Nearly all of our communications to the Membership comes through email. Please make sure you are receiving emails from us. If you feel you are not, please try the following...

- Check your junk file and make sure we are not getting kicked to junk.
  - Double check with the Golf Shop to make sure we have the correct email address for you. If your email address changes, we need to know.
- Hopefully any issues will be resolved by correcting one of the 2 things listed above.

**EVENTS** - We highly encourage all eligible Members to participate in our events. We keep the entry fees affordable with the payouts in Golf Shop Merchandise Credit and some side games that pay back prizes in cash. As part of your Membership, we include a USGA GHIN Handicap, but it is up to you to post ALL of your adjusted scores (at Valley View and elsewhere)...both 9 and 18 holes. It is simple to do with an App on your phone or using the Computer outside of the Golf Shop. Practically all of our events require an active Handicap and you will have that after you enter at least 3-18 hole scores (or enough 9 hole scores to add up to 3-18 holes). See the Golf Shop Staff on helping with setting up the App and posting scores. Please remember...we do not know your Apple ID, Passwords, etc...you will have to have that info to add Apps to your phone.

**QUESTIONS** - This covers a number of our rules and day to day policies. We know you will have questions and we are here to help. Contact the Golf Shop Staff and if we can't answer your question, we can almost surely find someone that can.
