### KELLY'S CORNER

Despite fighting intermittent showers, the aeration of greens went well and the rain actually helped heal the holes quicker. They are picking up a bit of pace, especially now that we are occasionally rolling them.

As we start to water more in the near future, please report any leaks to the Golf Shop so we can fix any problems we have.

PLEASE FOLLOW ALL CART ROUTING SIGNS AND STAY AT LEAST 30 FEET FROM THE GREENS WITH THE CARTS, FIX YOUR BALL MARKS, AND RAKE YOUR BUNKERS FOR THE ENJOYMENT OF ALL PLAYERS! FOR THOSE USING THE BLUE FLAGS, PLEASE STAY AT LEAST 10 FEET FROM THE GREENS AND AWAY FROM THE EDGES OF THE BUNKERS.

#### FORMAT

36 Hole Medal Play Format using Blue Tees on day 1 and Red Tees on day 2 for all players. The event will be Pre-Flighted using age divisions and handicap indexes within those divisions.

#### TEES

Round 1 will be played from the Blue Tees (the tips!). Round 2 will be played from the Red Tees.

#### PRIZES

The event payout will include prizes for both gross and net winners in each flight (approximately 30% of the field). Players may only receive one prize within their division. The Overall Gross Champion can come from any division.

#### FLIGHTING

The Age Divisions will be pre-determined based on the Club Championship age categories. The flights within those age categories will be determined after the field is set by handicap index.

#### ENTRY FEE

One time \$40 entry fee (plus appropriate cart fee).  
OPTIONAL SKINS \$20-Cash Payout (Half Gross & Half Net)

#### ELIGIBILITY

Open to all Valley View Golf Club Members (excluding those on Junior Memberships)

#### STARTING TIMES (Tee Times)

The Golf Shop Staff will assign pairings for both rounds. Time requests will be taken into consideration for round 1 (Saturday). Round 2 pairings will be made by flights and standings after round 1 scores within the flights. No requests for round 2. No time restrictions for Senior or Afternoon Members for this event.

### RULES OF PLAY

### TEES

#### REGULAR DIVISION...

First 36 holes - The Blue and Green Tees will be combined into a hybrid distance combining the 2 sets. The low 12 scores and ties will qualify for the Championship Flight. There will be a competitive mix of flights figured after the Championship Flight is figured. For the remainder of the event, the Championship and First Flights will play from the Blue Tees with the remainder of the flights in the Regular Division playing the Green Tees.

#### SENIOR DIVISION...

Play the White Tees for the entire event.

#### SUPER SENIOR & LEGENDS DIVISIONS...

Play the Gold Tees the entire event.

#### LADIES DIVISION...

Play the Red Tees the entire event.



### ENTRY FEE

One time \$20 entry fee (plus appropriate cart fee each round).
